### **KILCAR PARISH COUNCIL ELECTION**

The election of a new Parish Council will take place on 19th May with polling stations at Áislann Chill Chartha, Carrick Day Care Centre and Meenaneary Community Centre. Boxes for the nominations are available in Kilcar Post Office; Áislann Chill Chartha; Centra Supermarket, Kilcar; Byrne's Supermarket, Kilcar and Carrick; Doherty's Supermarket, Carrick; The Butcher Shop, Carrick and O'Donnell's Shop, Meenaneary. Any resident of the Kilcar parish aged 18 years or over may be nominated. You may nominate more than one person. The names of people nominated should be accompanied by a contact 'phone number if possible or at least an address. The process of nominating candidates will be open until 2nd May, when all the boxes will be collected and the people nominated contacted to find out if they are willing to be candidates in the election.

### **JOHN 20: "MY LORD AND MY GOD"**

Each of these two appearances of the risen Lord to his disciples has its special message. The first is, of all the resurrection appearances, the most joyful, unclouded by any doubt or hesitation. It is also, for John, the moment of the creation of the Church. Jesus breathes on his disciples the Spirit promised at the last Supper, which will be the life of the Church. This is the new creation of the people of God, the raising to life by the Spirit of the dead bones of Israel prophesied by Ezekiel. The Spirit is the life-principle of the Church, and the disciples are to impart the Spirit by the forgiveness of sin, for sin is death and distance from God, just as the presence of the Spirit gives closeness and a living relationship to God. In the second appearance the theme of doubt returns, only to be overcome by Thomas's confession. This confession forms a fitting conclusion to the gospel, the only full acknowledgement of Christ as God by anyone in the gospels, arching over to form a bracket with the prologue, "what God was, the Word was". This was the faith to which the gospel was to bring those "who have not seen and yet believe".
